<b>SYNEX INTERNATIONAL INC UPDATE ON PROJECT DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES</b>
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Synex International Inc. (the “Company”) is providing this update regarding activities involving the development of run-of-river hydroelectric plants by its wholly owned subsidiaries, Synex Energy Resources Ltd. (“Synex Energy”) and Sigma Engineering Ltd. (“Sigma”).

The Ahousaht First Nation, Synex Energy and Sigma have executed agreements under which the Ahous Business Corporation will own and develop the 15MW Bulson Creek Hydro Project located on the west coast of Vancouver Island. Sigma will participate as engineering consultants in the development and work closely with the Ahous Business Corporation.

Synex Energy has executed a non-binding term sheet with respect to potential partnering with an independent third party on the proposed 4.4MW Newcastle Creek Hydro Project and the proposed 5.3MW McKelvie Creek Hydro Project. The execution of the related agreements between Synex Energy and the third party is subject to a number of conditions including the approval of the Boards of the Company and the third party.

Synex Energy and the local mill have been in extended discussions regarding potential partnering to develop the 10MW Victoria Lake Hydro Project. The Company has recently been advised that the local mill is not interested in partnering, at this time. Synex Energy will continue with the development of the project. In August 2006, Synex Energy was awarded an electricity purchase agreement by BC Hydro for the project. Given the expected time necessary to receive water licence and land tenure approvals, Synex Energy has determined that it is advantageous to terminate the existing electricity purchase agreement with BC Hydro and to re-apply for an electricity purchase agreement at a future date, subject to the eligibility requirements at that time. Accordingly, Synex Energy and BC Hydro have agreed to terminate the existing electricity purchase agreement.

Sigma is continuing to finalize the acquisition of 36 water licence applications (the “Applications”) located in the Sechelt area of British Columbia. The Applications are being marketed for sale and discussions are ongoing with a number of prospective purchasers for some of the Applications.

The Company is a successful hydroelectric developer and consultant in British Columbia. The Company wholly owns or has proportionate interests in a total of 12 MW of operating facilities. In addition, the Company has applications for water licence and land tenure on over 55 potential hydroelectric sites which are in various stages of development or intended for disposition. Mostly, the water licence applications are for projects with individual capacities of less than 10 MW. BC Hydro under the current Standing Offer Program accepts applications for electricity purchase agreements for up to forty years for projects with a maximum size of 15 MW and for which BC Hydro has a stated goal of acquiring 150 GWH per year.
