SYNEX INTERNATIONAL INC. AGREEMENTS FOR SALE OF WATER LICENCE APPLICATIONS

Synex International Inc. (the “Company”) announces that Sigma Engineering Ltd. (“Sigma”), a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company, has entered into two agreements under which it has agreed to sell 5 water licence applications (the “Applications”) to independent third parties. The Applications were previously acquired by Sigma from the Receiver for Hawkeye Energy Corporation (the “Receiver”). Sigma will provide consulting services for the development of the 5 projects and is continuing to market the additional 31 water licence applications acquired from the Receiver.

Separately, the Company is pleased to have been listed as 58th of the Top 100 fastest-growing companies in British Columbia as published by Business in Vancouver.

Synex International Inc. is an experienced run of river hydroelectric developer and consultant located in Vancouver, British Columbia. The Company wholly owns or has interests in 12 MW of operating facilities and has applications for water licences and land tenure on over 55 potential hydroelectric sites which are either in various stages of development or are being held for disposition.
