SYNEX INTERNATIONAL INC. COMPLETES \$315,000 PRIVATE PLACEMENT

Synex International Inc. (the "Company") is pleased to announce that it has completed a non-brokered private placement (the "Private Placement") of 700,000 common shares in the capital of the Company (each a "Share") at a price of \$0.45 per Share for gross proceeds of \$315,000. The Private Placement was previously announced on May 15, 2015.

The Shares will be restricted from trading for a period of four months and one day from the date of issuance. The total finders' fees payable under the Private Placement were \$585.

The net proceeds from the Private Placement will be used for general corporate purposes, including working capital.

Synex International Inc. is an experienced run of river hydroelectric developer and consultant located in Vancouver, British Columbia. The Company wholly owns or has interests in 12 MW of operating facilities and has applications for water licences and land tenure on over 55 potential hydroelectric sites which are either in various stages of development or are being held for disposition.
