Synex International Inc. (the “Company”) announces that effective April 3, 2017, Alan W. Stephens is retiring as a Director and Chairman of the Board of the Company. After many years of service, Alan has decided that, in his words, the time to move on has arrived.

Alan was the founder of the Company in 1984 and its predecessor company, Sigma Engineering Ltd., in 1973 and was a pioneer in independent hydro power plant development in British Columbia. He has acted in one or more of the roles of Board Chair, Director, President and Corporate Secretary since inception. The Company will sorely miss his guidance and drive and wishes Alan all the best in his retirement.

The Company is a successful hydroelectric developer and consultant in British Columbia. The Company wholly owns or has proportionate interests in a net total of 12 MW of operating facilities and 9 MW of construction ready facilities. In addition, the Company has applications for water licences and land tenure on 24 potential hydroelectric sites totaling over 150 MW of installed capacity.
