Synex International Inc. (“Synex” or the “Company”) is pleased to announce the results of its Annual General Meeting of Shareholders (the “Meeting”) held on November 3, 2017. All nominees proposed by management of the Company were elected. The Meeting had a turnout in person or by proxy representing approximately 98.2% of the Company’s issued and outstanding shares, as at the record date for the Meeting.

“I would like to thank our shareholders for their support and patience during the proxy contest”, said Clifford A. Grandison, Chairman of the Company. “Synex’s board and management do not take lightly the trust placed in them by shareholders. We are excited to go back to business, developing our next two projects for 9 MW in increased generation, and will continue to act in the best interests of Synex and all its shareholders.”

Tanya L. DeAngelis, E. Lee Rennison, Clifford A. Grandison, Mark A. Stephens and Gregory J. Sunell were re-elected to the board of directors of the Company (the “Board”) and a new director, David K. Plunkett, was also elected to the Board.

Mr. Plunkett is a founding partner at Burrard Law LLP, with a practice that includes construction law, professional liability, corporate-commercial, employment and insurance law matters. Mr. Plunkett also serves as Chair of the Canadian Bar Association (CBA) Construction and Infrastructure Section in Ottawa. Mr. Plunkett formerly led the construction law group at a leading British Columbia law firm specialized in construction and insurance law.

At the Meeting, shareholders also voted in favour of the appointment of Dale Matheson Carr-Hilton Labonte LLP as auditors of the Company at remuneration to be approved by the Board.

The Company is an experienced hydroelectric developer and consultant in British Columbia. The Company wholly-owns or has proportionate interests in a net total of 12 MW of operating facilities and 9 MW of construction ready facilities.
